Gabrielle Peterson

Gabrielle Peterson is completing her BA in Theatre at USC with a cognate in Dramatic Literature focusing on Shakespearian analysis. She recently received the Magellan Grant to write and direct a play later this year. She debuted at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, the largest theatre festival in the world, in 2007 and continued to perform internationally as a member of the Edinburgh University Savoy Opera Company in 2009. Her training also includes private vocal instruction for nine years with involvement in several choirs as well as dance classes in tap, jazz, musical theatre, and West African styles for five years. Gabrielle can often be found teaching theatre at different training programs in the state. She has run her own arts classes at the Village Square Theatre Summer Arts Program and served as an Assistant Instructor at the Tri-District Arts Consortium.

Christopher holds an MFA in Directing for the Stage from Roosevelt University's Theatre Conservatory in Chicago. A member of the Society of American Fight Directors, he is the Resident Fight Choreographer for SCSC. He is an Adjunct Professor of Theatre and Speech Communication at Newberry College as well as Midlands Technical College.
